

HALF SQUARE TRIANGLES

-ONE AT A TIME METHOD-

QUILTY MATH

Finished Half Square Triangle (HST) size is the size it will be when sewn into the finished quilt.

Unfinished HST is $\frac{1}{2}$ inch larger than the finished size.

INSTRUCTIONS:

- Cut 2 fabric squares in the exact size that you want your unfinished HST to be.
- Draw a line on the backside of one of the fabrics from corner to corner diagonally across the square.
- Sew directly on top of the drawn line.
- Trim the squares $\frac{1}{4}$ inch away from the stitched line.
- Gently press the HST unit open to one side or press the seam open.
