

HALF SQUARE TRIANGLES

-TWO AT A TIME METHOD- QUILTY MATH

Finished Half Square Triangle (HST) size is the size it will be when sewn into the finished quilt.

Unfinished HST is 1/2 inch larger than the finished size.

For Two at a Time method - Cut Two Fabric Squares 1 INCH larger than the desired finished size.

INSTRUCTIONS:

- Cut 2 fabric squares 1 inch larger than the desired finished unit size.
- Draw a line on the backside of one of the fabrics from corner to corner diagonally across the square.
- Sew 1/4 inch away from each side of the drawn line. (You will have two stitched lines)
- Trim the squares directly on top of the drawn diagonal line.
- Gently press each HST unit open to one side or press the seam open.
- Trim the unit to the desired unfinished size.
